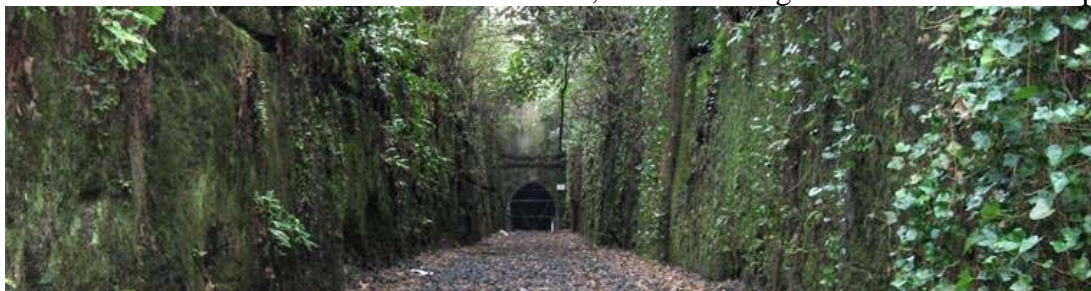
Coming up:
